<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Are these issues similar to other sectors?▪ What sector strengths, weaknesses, and opportunities are regional in nature?	
45 min	Sector Priorities – Think Regionally, Act Locally
<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ What types of projects are needed in the sector to build on strengths, address weakness, take advantage of opportunities, or reduce threats?▪ For example....<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ new roadway construction○ intersection improvement○ existing roadway reconstruction / enhancement○ new bridge○ new trail○ bus service enhancement / extension▪ Which projects have the highest priority (1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th.....)?<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Do they meet multiple needs?○ Do they reinforce other efforts?○ Would they engender community support?○ Would they leverage investment or re-investment?
