




NITE RIDE LIMITED SERVICE

SOUTH Loop continuing as STOCKYARDS Industrial Park Loop

1. This loop starts and ends at the Downtown Transfer Center and will pick up and deliver passengers on the "South" loop, which takes 30 minutes.
2. Upon return to the Transfer Center, this bus will change destination and deliver and pick up passengers on the "Stockyards" loop. This 45 minute loop will end at the Transfer Center and repeat steps 1 and 2

How to read this Timetable

"Nite Ride" service starts at 9:15 p.m. and continues through 5:15 a.m, with a 1/2 hour break in service between 1:30 a.m. and 2:00 a.m., Monday night though Saturday morning.

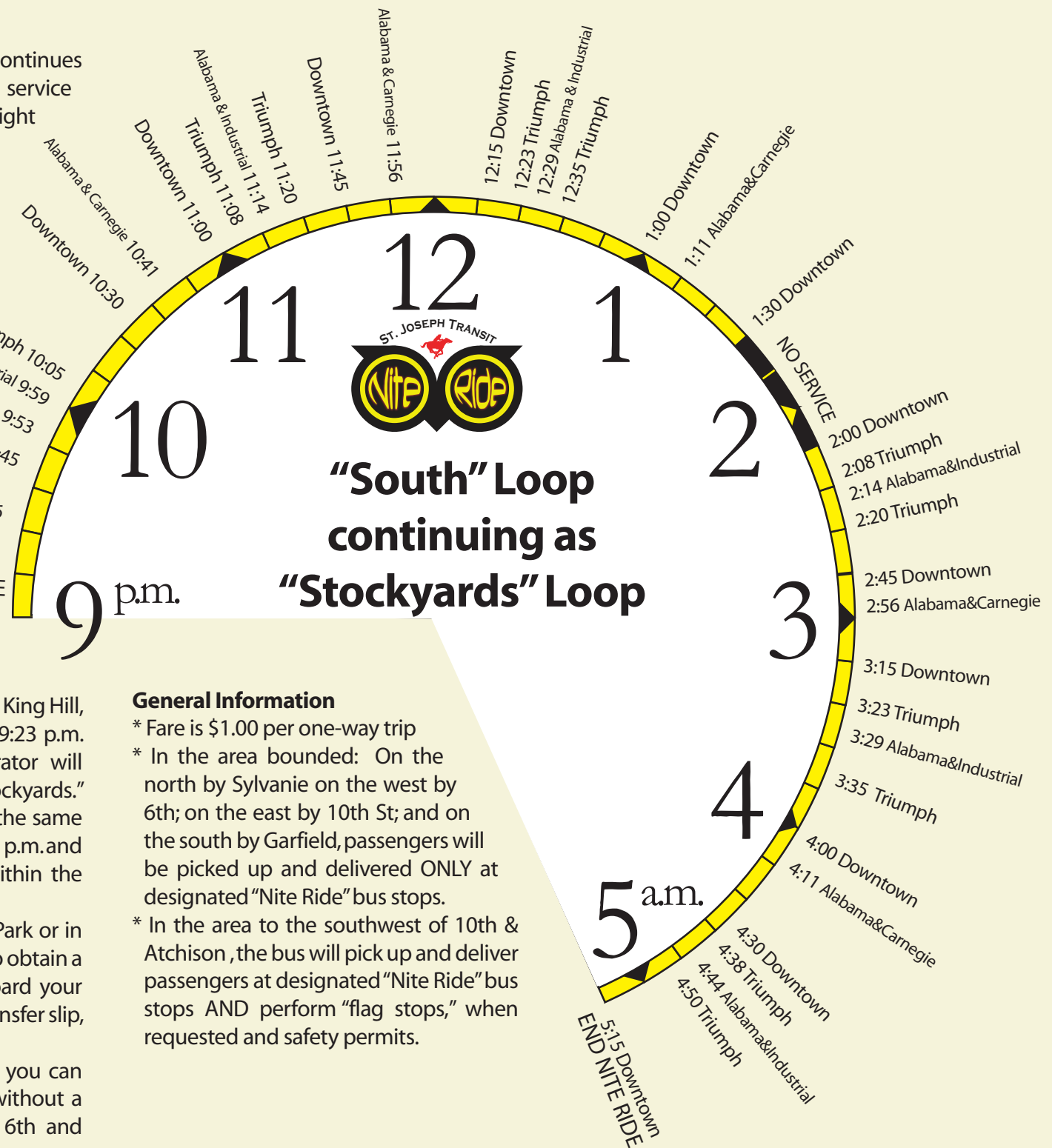
The times listed on the timetable indicate that the bus will not leave the designated time points prior to the time listed.

Example 1: If you work in the "Stockyards" Industrial Park and you must be at work by 11:00 p.m. You must leave on the "Stockyards" bus from Downtown at 9:45 p.m. Assuming you live near King Hill & Alabama, you will catch the "South" Loop bus.

To make sure you don't miss the bus, look at the timetable and find the nearest time point prior to your stop, Alabama & Carnegie. The bus will not leave that point prior to 9:23 and since is only a few minutes away from your nearest bus stop, at 6010 South King Hill, you should be at the bus stop no later than 9:23 p.m. When the bus arrives downtown, the operator will change the destination of the bus to read "Stockyards." Since this is your destination, you will stay on the same bus that will arrive at Stockyards between 10:00 p.m. and 10:30 p.m, depending on your destination within the business park.

Example 2: If you work in "Eastside" Industrial Park or in "Mitchell Woods" Industrial Park, you will have to obtain a free transfer slip from the bus operator, deboard your bus downtown and board the bus, using the transfer slip, marked for your desired destination.

If you live near the Downtown Transit Center, you can catch the appropriate industrial park routes, without a transfer, by walking to the Transit Center at 6th and Angelique.



General Information

- * Fare is \$1.00 per one-way trip
- * In the area bounded: On the north by Sylvaniae on the west by 6th; on the east by 10th St; and on the south by Garfield, passengers will be picked up and delivered ONLY at designated "Nite Ride" bus stops.
- * In the area to the southwest of 10th & Atchison, the bus will pick up and deliver passengers at designated "Nite Ride" bus stops AND perform "flag stops," when requested and safety permits.
